Background/General Description

Established in 1944, the World Bank Group (WBG) is one of the world's largest sources of funding and knowledge for development solutions. The WBG is organized around 14 Global Practices (GPs) including the Governance Global Practice (GGP). The World Bank Group Governance Global Practice (GGP) comprises a variety of different professional disciplines working on public institutions, including public sector management, governance and anti-corruption, procurement, financial management, social accountability and justice reform. The Financial Accountability and Reporting (FA&R) Group focuses on transparency, financial accountability, and financial Reporting in the private and public sectors. This also includes accountability of institutions, oversight bodies and regulators, as well as Financial Management (FM) functions of Bank-funded operations.

Duties and Accountabilities

The GGP is seeking a Financial Management Local Consultant for 60 days until June 30, 2018 to work within the fiduciary team. Based in Maputo - Mozambique, the Financial Management Local Consultant is expected to assume among others the following duties and responsibilities:

- Assess the adequacy of the Borrower's project financial management systems and their ability to manage and monitor World Bank financed projects;
- Carry out supervision work to ensure that projects financial management systems are functioning appropriately;
- Provide guidance and advice to borrowers and Bank staff on capacity building in projects and with public sector accountability institutions;
- Provide necessary support for progress in effective use of

country FM systems for not only Bank-financed projects but also other foreign aid coming to Mozambique:

- Be actively engaged in public financial management, governance, and fiscal decentralization reform programs of Mozambique.

Selection Criteria

To be considered for this position, the Financial Management Consultant will have the following qualifications and skills:

- CPA, CA, ACCA, or 4-5 years of equivalent university education in accounting, business, finance or economics, and a minimum of 5 years of post-qualification experience in financial management. Also, the ideal candidates should have:
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively, in writing and orally, both in Portuguese and in English;
- Knowledge of International Accounting Standards and International Standards on Auditing;
- Experience and in-depth familiarity with development agenda in general, and public sector financial management reforms in general;
- Experience in auditing, including assessing audit competence, and the ability to analyze the impact of qualified audit reports and matters arising from management letters;
