1. This invitation for bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in *Development Business*, issue no. 839 of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2013.
2. The Republic of Mozambique has received a credit from the International Development Association toward the cost of Greater Maputo Water Supply Expansion Project (GMWSP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for Construction of Primary Distribution Network for Malhemele and Guava.
3. The Fundo de Investimentos e Património do Abastecimento de Água (FIPAG), now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Construction of Primary Distribution Network for Malhemele and Guava. The period for construction is 13 months and the scope is summarized but not limited to:
  - a. Construction of approximately 60km of primary distribution network in Malhemele and Guava;
  - c. Installation of district water meter and control valves and will interface at defined points where this primary network will be connected to the Malhemele and Guava Distribution Centers;
  - d. The work will include installation of all fittings and ancillary works as per the GMWSP safeguard documents and Mozambican legislation, including the environmental and social safeguard's framework.
4. Bidding will be conducted through the national competitive bidding procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: *Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 and revised July 2014*. The bidding is open to bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the Guidelines and available at: [www.worldbank.org/procurement](http://www.worldbank.org/procurement).
5. Qualifications requirements are detailed in the bidding document and include: the minimum average annual construction turnover within the last 5 years shall be USD 10,000,000 (Ten million United State Dollars). Experience under construction contracts in the role of prime contractor, JV member, sub-contractor or management contractor for at least the last 5 years prior to the bid submission deadline. Participation as a prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor, in at least (i) two (2) similar contracts, each of minimum value of USD 6,000,000 (Six million United State Dollars), or (ii) three (3) similar contracts, each of minimum value of USD 4,000,000 (Four million United State Dollars).
6. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from FIPAG and inspect the bidding document at the address given below from 8:30 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 16:00 hrs during workdays.
7. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee of USD 130.00 (One hundred and thirty United State Dollars or equivalent, at the exchange rate of payment date). The method of payment will be by cash, direct deposit or bank transfer to FIPAG - Fundo de Investimento e Património do Abastecimento de Água, Meticals Account no. 8992580, Millenium BIM Bank, Swift code: BIMOMZMX or USD Account no. 100108022028, ABC Bank, Swift code: FMBZMZX. The bidding document will be sent by courier for overseas delivery and surface mail or courier for local delivery if the bidder pays the delivery charges.
8. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 14H00 on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of USD 90,000.00 (Ninety thousand United States Dollars) or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 14.30 on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019.
9. Pre-bid meeting and site visit will take place on 14<sup>th</sup> June 2019, at 09:00 am at the FIPAG Offices, located at the address below.
