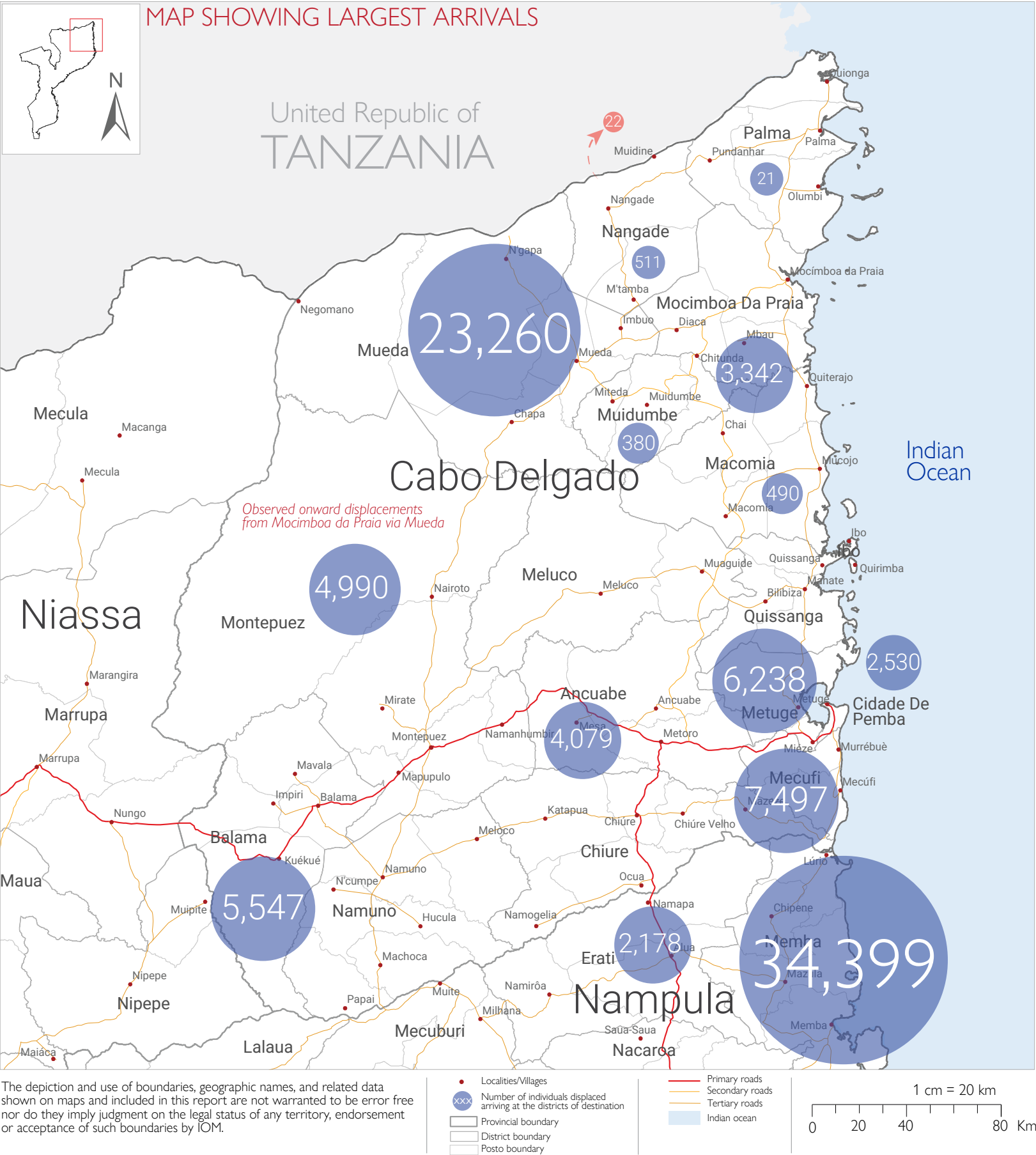


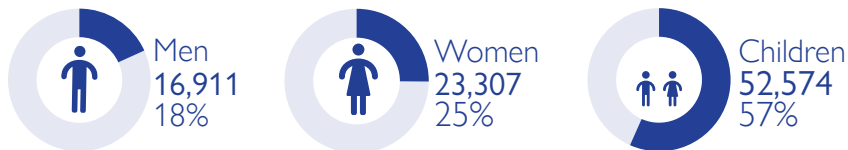
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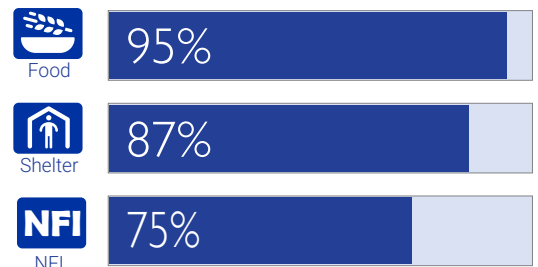
Between 22 September and 13 October 2025, escalating attacks by Non-State Armed Groups (NSAGs) triggered new waves of displacement across Cabo Delgado and some parts of Nampula province. In Mocimboa da Praia, ongoing insecurity in Bairro 30 de Junho and Felipe Nyusi displaced an estimated 28,401 individuals. In Balama, around 5,629 people fled from Mpake and Mavala localities (Mavala posto) to Ntete and Mize. In Montepuez, approximately 4,049 individuals were displaced within the district, moving from Mararange, Mirate, and Nacololo to Nacuca and Mararange villages. In Chiure, 10,221 individuals were displaced from Mazeze, Chiure Velho and Ocuia to Metuge and Mize postos in Metuge. Recent attacks in Memba district (Nampula Province) also forced 39,982 individuals to flee from Chipene and Necoro villages to Lurio, Chipene and Mazua postos within the district. Additional movements were recorded in Mecufi (7,497 individuals), Metuge (6,238 individuals), Ancuabe (4,079 individuals), Pemba (2,530 individuals), Erati (2,178 individuals), Nangade (511 individuals), Macomia (490 individuals) and Muidumbe (380 individuals). 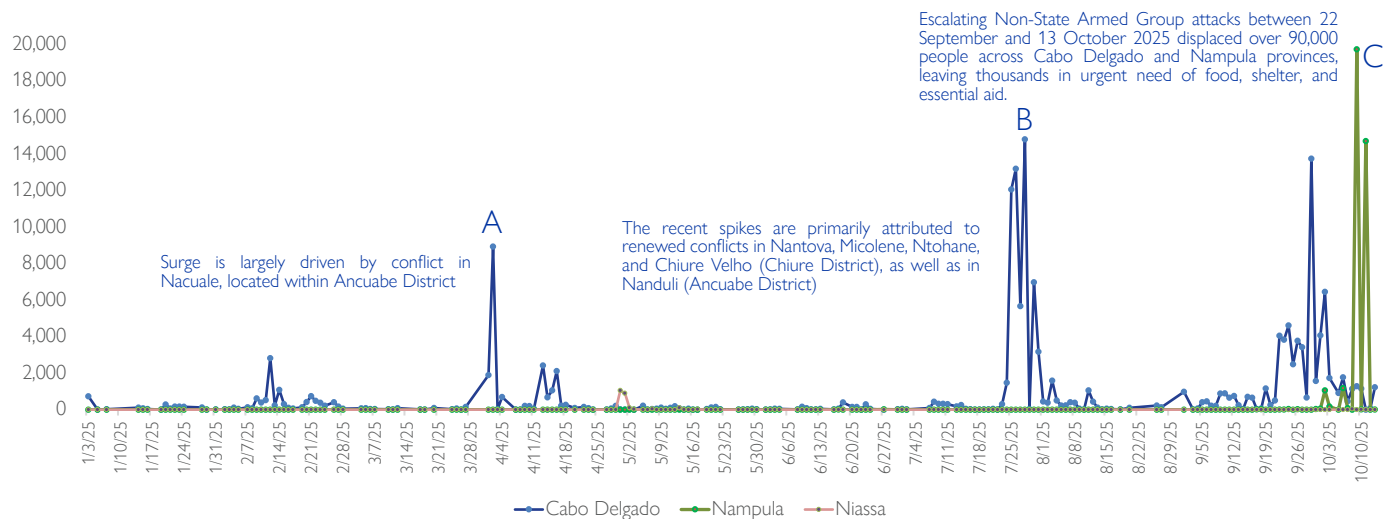
Top three most urgent needs expressed as a percentage of the population, noting that the Key Informants highlighted multiple needs by different groups of individuals.

Owing to prevailing security concerns in the region reported by displaced families, intentions on the duration of their stay in current locations of displacement sites and host communities remain uncertain. The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) – Movement Alert is to collect information on large and sudden population movements, providing humanitarian response partners with data on IDPs to support effective humanitarian response. Information is collected through key informants' interviews or direct observation. Assessments are conducted on a daily basis. This alert provides basic information on displacements, and additional information can be shared upon request.
